Stage 1: NCC Professional Diploma in Strategic Business IT

PROGRAM INFORMATION

1. Program Completion Time The minimum completion time is 9 months and the maximum is THREE* years (*subject to course availability).

2. Class Hours

Approximate total hours of scheduled lectures, tutorials, and student group discussion/work are 280 hours approx per module.

3. Assessment

Assignment for each subject is by an assignment. A student may resit for a failed subject to a resit fee.

4. Course Schedule

Normally ONE module is to be completed in a ten week term. Typically the classes will be scheduled:

- a) Weekly mode: a number of half day / 3 hour sessions at weekends (Sat PM, Sun AM), or one weekday evenings after 7:00pm by local
- b) Occasional Intensive Mode (overseas tutor): one week course plus local tutorial:

5. Class Venues

Classes will normally be held at:

- a) ABRS Centres at Wanchai with full computer / video projection facilities

6. Course Tutors

All modules are conducted by NCC approved tutors with postgraduate qualifications plus rich academic & industrial experience (typically with over 5 years tertiary / Master level teaching experience and over 15 professional experiences).

7. Internet Video Learning Support The course offers a recorded video mode of study for travelling students (separate service fee may apply).

8. Admission Requirement

- a) A good undergraduate degree from a recognised university in IT or related fields.
- b) Non-IT Degrees with 3 years related technical work experience.
- c) Professional Experience Entry: Other qualifications (e.g. Higher Diploma, Diploma in IT with strong industrial experience of 5 years at minimum) may enrol subject to assessment by the NCC and ABRS.

A. HKSAR Government Assistance and Funds (for reference only)

There are a variety of funding and aids for your course of study:

- 1. Continued Education Fund: You may apply for 80% of the Strategic Business Analysis tuition fee. The maximum CEF fund for each qualified HK resident is up to a maximum of HK\$10,000.
- 2. Non Means Loan from HKSAR Government Student Finance Office for full amount of tuition fees of the Professional Diploma 100%
- 3. Group Enrolment Discount a limited quota applies for enrolment of group two / three persons within the SAME intake
- 4. Early Bird Award: A limited number of award is available for early enrolment at least 30 days prior to commencement.

B. Fixed Term Payment Scheme Scholarship

Candidates who enrolled (separate scheme & agreement) in a Fixed Term Payment Plan (without suspension / deferral of study) and with approved payment methods (Loan, or cash/check) is eligible for maximum of HK\$4000 scholarship upon their successful completion of NCC PDSBIT programme – must apply and seek approval in entry.

C. Specified University, Institutes and Achievement Scholarship:
